Referee

- Must be able to roller blade/skate to assist with on floor clinics and learn to skate classes
- Hockey knowledge preferred
- Possess general reading, writing and mathematical skills
- 15 years of age with ability to provide work permit if required

Restaurant Host

Restaurant Hosts are responsible for not only providing daily serving of food/beverage but in addition to managing birthday party groups as needed.

 - Must be 21 years of age; the facility does currently hold a liquor license
 - Friendly and helpful with good communication skills
 - Will be required to obtain a food handlers card as well as take appropriate “Responsible Beverage” training
 - Comfortable working with food & beverage items while following required protocol as determined by the county health offices
 - Possess strong computer skill knowledge to be able to quickly pick up POS systems needed for all sales transactions; additionally a good knowledge of math and currency
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Front Desk

Front Desk staff are responsible for being the first contact when a family or athlete enters the facility.

- Available week days 4pm to 10pm and week ends 10am to 8pm
- Friendly and helpful with good communication skills
